It is ORDERED, effective immediately, that all civil rights complaints, petitions for writ of habeas corpus, and such other matters received from persons in custody, together with civil cases wherein the parties have consented for trial before the Magistrate, and all matters and cases designated for handling by full-time Magistrates by the Local Rules for the Assignment of Duties to U. S. Magistrates shall be referred to the full-time Magistrates for the Eastern District of Texas as follows:


Honorable Houston Abel	Tyler Division Sherman Division and Paris Division

Honorable Earl H. Hines	1/2 Beaumont Division and Lufkin Division

Assignment of additional duties will be made as deemed appropriate by the Judges of this Court. This Order is not intended to affect the previous orders of referral by this Court to half-time U. S. Magistrate Roger Sanders at Sherman, Texas.




