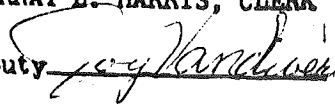

GENERAL ORDER

On June 27, 1984, this Court entered an order providing that any cause assigned to this Court wherein Charles H. Clark became enrolled as counsel of record for any party would thereafter be transferred to the docket of the Honorable William Wayne Justice, due to the fact that one of this Court's law clerks, Andy W. Tindel, had accepted an offer to practice law with Charles H. Clark. Because the Court is convinced that the appearance of propriety and fairness has now been fully served, the Court deems it appropriate to resume supervision and control over any cause it might draw in the future involving the appearance of Charles H. Clark as counsel of record. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Court's Order of June 27, 1984 governing transfer of cases involving Charles H. Clark is hereby VACATED. Any cause filed after the date of this Order in which Charles H. Clark appears as attorney of record for any party shall hereafter be assigned in accordance with Clerk of the Court's draw and the general orders of the Eastern District of Texas.
