The Honorable Howell Cobb, United States District Judge for the Eastern District of Texas, having recused himself from participating in any litigation involving parties represented by the law firm of Orgain, Bell & Tucker, of which he was formerly a member, until January 11, 1986, accordingly it is

ORDERED that when, in the operation of the random assignment system, an action is assigned to such judge which involves a party represented by Orgain, Bell & Tucker, the assignment so made shall immediately be invalidated, and such action shall be randomly assigned to another judge of this court, forthwith. It is further

ORDERED that all actions presently assigned to such judge which involve parties represented by Orgain, Bell & Tucker shall be re-assigned randomly to other judges of this court, forthwith. It is further

ORDERED that this order shall have no further force or effect on and after January 11, 1986.
