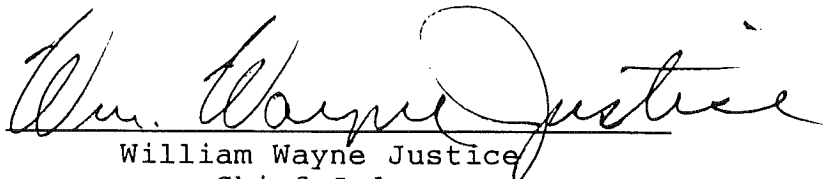
It is further
