GENERAL ORDER

86-6: Assignment of Motions to Withdraw Reference

It appearing that under 28 U.S.C. §157(d) parties may move to withdraw reference of an action from the Bankruptcy Court, for cause shown; and

It further appearing that a portion of the Beaumont Division civil calendar is assigned to judges residing outside such division, and that immediate assignment of these motions by lot may result in unnecessary delay, if the name of a judge residing outside the Beaumont Division is drawn. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that when motions for withdrawal of reference under 28 U.S.C. \$157(d) are filed in the Beaumont Division, they are to be directed forthwith to judges residing in the Beaumont Division for an initial ruling. In instances where an order is entered allowing withdrawal, the moving parties shall then present the motion, accompanying order, and a completed civil cover sheet to the assignment desk, for assignment of the

proceeding to a judge, by lot. It is further

ORDERED that motions under 28 U.S.C. §157(d) which are filed in the remaining divisions of this Court shall immediately be assigned upon filing.
