MOTIONS FOR 5K1.1 DEPARTURES
UNDER THE SENTENCING REFORM ACT

In order to provide adequate review and consideration of motions to depart from the Sentencing Guidelines pursuant to Chapter 5, Section K1.1, the following procedure is adopted:

- A. All motions for a 5K1.1 departure are to be filed in writing with the sentencing court a minimum of five (5) working days prior to sentencing.
- B. The motions shall provide in detail the appropriate sentencing(s) of 5K1.1 relied upon to petition the court for a departure.
- C. All motions filed under this order should be contemporaneously provided to the U.S. Probation Office as well as counsel for the defendant.
