ORDER

WHEREAS, part-time United States Magistrate Charles Lee Attaway was duly appointed to serve in the Eastern District of Texas with a duty station at Texarkana, Texas, on January 2, 1990, by Order duly entered and filed for record on December 29, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Judges of the United States District Court for the Western District of Arkansas have designated part-time United States Magistrate Charles Lee Attaway as part-time United States Magistrate of the Western District of Arkansas, pursuant to the provisions of Title 28, United States Code, Section 631(a); and

WHEREAS, the concurrence of the Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Texas is needed for the designation of part-time United States



Magistrate Charles Lee Attaway to serve in the United States District Court for the Western District of Arkansas; it is therefore

ORDERED that Charles Lee Attaway is designated to serve the Eastern District of Texas and the Western District of Arkansas at his duty station in Texarkana, Texas, and, it is further

ORDERED that the said Charles Lee Attaway be and is hereby authorized to perform all the powers and duties under the provisions of Section 636(a)(1) and Section 636(a)(2), Title 28, United States Code and Section 3401(a), Title 18, United States Code.
