General Procedures for Processing Miscellaneous Criminal Matters in the Eastern District of Texas

In Divisions within this District in which United States Magistrate Judges are stationed, the following motions, petitions, applications, or requests, made by the United States Attorney and presented for filing by the Clerk, shall be filed of record, assigned a Magistrate Docket Number, and forthwith shall be transmitted to the Magistrate Judge on duty for ruling thereupon:

Pen Register Applications

Transponder Applications

Application for Non Disclosure of Grand Jury Subpoena

Application for Search Warrant

Application for Seizure Warrant

Petition for Arrest Warrant

Motions Relating to Production of Tax Returns for Use in Criminal Prosecutions

In the absence of a Magistrate Judge, the above matters may be presented to a U. S. District Judge for ruling.

Title III Applications for Wiretap, made by the United States Attorney and presented to the Clerk for filing, shall continue to be filed of record, assigned a Miscellaneous Docket Number, and forthwith shall be transmitted to the District Judge for ruling thereupon.
