
ORDER ON ASSIGNMENT OF BANKRUPTCY APPEALS

IT IS ORDERED that all appeals to the District Court, arising from the same Bankruptcy Court case, whether interlocutory, final judgment, or order of dismissal, be assigned to the judge to whom the first appeal from such bankruptcy case was assigned, by lot.

Each appeal shall receive a separate District Court civil number and also carry the related Bankruptcy Court case number, even if the appeal is filed in an adversary proceeding.

Bankruptcy appeals filed prior to the date of this order shall remain as previously assigned, subject to further order of the assigned judge.
