## **Establishment of Date of Arrest of Criminal Defendants**

With the implementation of automated docketing of criminal cases, it becomes imperative that the date of arrest of criminal defendants be entered in the record in chronological sequence in order to initiate automated speedy trial timeclock intervals for tracking purposes.
