
**ORDER REGARDING CRIMINAL CASE ASSIGNMENTS**

On several occasions there have been simultaneously pending before the court multiple criminal offenses involving the same defendant. These matters were prosecuted separately and were separately assigned to judges by random draw. Justice and judicial economy would best be served by the assignment of such matters to one judicial officer.

It is therefore ORDERED that any new indictment(s) and/or information(s) pertaining to a defendant who has other criminal charges pending against him/her in this court shall be assigned to the judge whose name was drawn by random lot at the time of the filing of the first such case.

Further, it is ORDERED that the United States Attorney shall give written notice to the court and clerk of the relatedness of new filings to any previously-filed pending case(s) involving the same defendant to ensure that the proper judicial assignment is made.
